
Awaking Wonder China



CULTURE:

Introduce your child to China by reading legends, stories, and personal accounts about life in China. Pay attention to traditions, language, holidays, food, and landmarks. Find out what the Chinese flag looks like and what the colors and emblems symbolize.

EXPLORE:

From the Great Wall of China to the Yangtze River to the Silk Road, there is much to explore in China! As you read about the Great Wall of China, let your child build a Lego model. Find the Yangtze River on a map and pay attention to how many cities are along its route to the East China Sea. Map the Silk Road and find out what you can about making silk. Read about the Terracotta Army and the excavation still taking place.



COOK:

Visit an Asian market. Choose some items to purchase and try at home. A basic part of Asian cuisine is rice. With supervison, teach your child how to steam rice.

PRAY:

Biographies are listed below of missionaries who served in China, and for older children, *The Red Scarf Girl* gives a first person account of a young girl who lived during the Chinese Cultural Revolution.
