Read Numbers 13 about the 12 spies Moses sent to explore Canaan. What did the spies find out? What were their reactions? Read further to discover the consequences of their actions. Share with your child a time that God gave you courage to do the right thing. Memorize Joshua 1:9 together.

From spies to code breakers, there are many professions that use observation skills paired with logic to learn information. Though they are often associated with war times, people can serve undercover in missions like smuggling Bibles into communist countries, too. Read biographies of some people who worked in classified positions. What challenges did they face? How did they persevere?

Spies disguise their appearances and even their native language/accent to work in countries far from home. What kind of disguise can your child come up with using things you already have on hand?
