God created the earth with seasonal changes and keeps their order. Read Psalm 1 and Ecclesiastes 3:1-15 together. Ask your children to describe seasonal changes where you live. Talk about how God orders those changes. Then discuss seasons of life and how God keeps us in His care through each one.

The seasons of the year have inspired many poets to try to capture their essence with words. This year, select some poems to read repeatedly each month that reflect the season you are in. Try to read some of these outside if you are able. Take a walk together and discuss the things God made that bring you wonder each season. Let these moments inspire your child's creative expression.

For each month or each season this year, help your child choose one location to observe seasonal changes. Take a photo of that place each month or season.
