SERVE:

JONI:

Joni Eareckson Tada was paralyzed when she was 17. Despite her physical limitations, Joni has stewarded the gifts God equipped her with. As you learn about Joni, look for how she uses her gifts in ministry, advocacy, art, and music.

CORRIE:



During World War 2, Corrie ten Boom helped hide Jews in Nazi occupied Holland and later shared the gospel with fellow prisoners. After the war, she travelled the world sharing her testimony--including how God helped her forgive. Ask your children to look at the people in their lives and think of ways they can help or encourage them.
