This is what the Lord says: “Stand by the ways and see and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; then you will find a resting place for your souls. Jeremiah 6:16

But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn that shines brighter and brighter until the full day. Proverbs 4:18

Our lives are journeys and often times we don't realize how long and exhausting parts of our journey would be. Read and reflect on the verses as you consider how you can build a personal connection with God as you seek to follow his ways and grow in wisdom, patience, and endurance. As you ponder these verses, can you commit some to memory to help you hold fast to God?

You will make known to me the way of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; in Your right hand there are pleasures forever. Psalm 16:11

Make me know Your ways, Lord; teach me Your paths. Lead me in Your truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the day. Psalm 25:4-5

In the way of righteousness there is life, and in its pathway there is no death. Proverbs 12:28

Culture gives us permission to compromise. Are there areas in your life where you feel the pressure of culture? Are you tempted right now to go down the wrong path because you are tired or feel that God doesn't see you? Turn from it as you read these verses and be encouraged to hold fast to the path of wisdom. Reflect on these verses as you realign your vision to God's path.

Do not enter the path of the wicked and do not proceed in the way of evil people. Avoid it, do not pass by it; Turn away from it and pass on. Proverbs 4:14-15

Their feet run to evil, and they hurry to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of wrongdoing, devastation and destruction are in their paths. they do not know the way of peace, and there is no justice in their tracks; they have made their paths crooked, whoever walks on them does not know peace. Isaiah 59:7-8

Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. Matthew 7:13

The Holy Spirit teaches us the way to go and reminds us of the ways of God. The path of God's righteousness is a way of peace. Pray that you can put aside sin and the things that entangle and hold fast to the path of wisdom

And He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of people." Matthew 4:19

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me. Matthew 16:24

And He was saying to them all, "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Me. Luke 9:23

If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him. John 12:26

Therefore, since we also have such a great cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let's rid ourselves of every obstacle and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let's run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking only at Jesus, the originator and perfecter of the faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding. He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; he is a shield to those who walk in integrity, guarding the paths of justice, And He watches over the way of His godly ones. Then you will discern righteousness, justice, and integrity, and every good path. Proverbs 2:6-9

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

I have instructed you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in upright paths. Proverbs 4:11

But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him. James 1:5

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119:105
