In the Bible, God gives us many word pictures (metaphors) so that we can more fully understand His character and see Him rightly. In this Bible Study, Sally asks, "What is the Way, the Path of God? What did it mean that Jesus said he was the way?"

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6

How do you choose which way to walk? Consider this literally and then apply those same concepts to your spiritual life journey.

The pathways that we choose each day determine where we will end up. We have choices and those choices have consequences.

Use a concordance (most Bibles have one in the back) and look up some verses with the words "way" or "path" in them. (A few verses to start with: Psalm 1, Prov. 12:28, Isaiah 35:8, Psalm 16:11, Acts 24:14.) How do these verses relate to Jesus describing Himself as the Way? Choose one verse to memorize for encouragement.

Where in your life do you have a decision to make? Pray over it in light of these concepts. The Lord will guide you in His way as you trust Him with your circumstances and future.
