How will you invest your life?

Psalm 16:5-6 The Lord is the portion of my inheritance and my cup; You support my lot. The measuring lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; Indeed, my inheritance is beautiful to me.

Read Romans 5:1-5. Where does the “hope that does not disappoint” come from? What part of this process are you in today? Is there a particular tribulation that you would like to see God’s hand in? Pray that He would reveal His HOPE to you today.
